Lightning Sensor v4 – Switch waterproof caps replacement



Your Lightning Sensor v4 comes with two waterproof caps, each one being screwed on a switch.

These caps are essential to protect your trigger electronics from any water or dust infiltration.

As handling goes by, depending on users, these caps can wear out and crack, no longer fullfilling their protective role.

A 10 years warranty is given for your Lightning Sensor v4, against all assembly or electronics operting fault.

This warranty does not cover water or dust infiltration damage due to cracked waterproof caps.

Waterpoof caps are wear and tear parts, so they are not covered by the 10 years warranty.

To maintain effective the 10 years warranty of your Lightning Sensor v4, it is your responsibility to replace the caps as soon as they show wear signs.

How to replace the waterproof caps ?

During our Lightning Sensor v4 assembly, the waterproof caps have been screwed and tightened by hand on the switches thread.

For their replacement, proceed one cap at a time (do not remove both caps at the same time).

Also, keep in place the circular, thick washer located under the cap.

Loosen by hand the first worn cap, then replace it with a new one.

Tighten the cap, always by hand, until the stop. Do not use pliers.

Once this new cap is installed and tightened, proceed likewise for the second worn cap.

Do not throw the worn caps in the domestic bin. Put them in your recycling tray.
